TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDERS

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION

**ABSTRACT**

This Report relates to the making of Temporary Traffic Orders as detailed below.

The Committee is requested to note that the undernoted Temporary Traffic Orders have been made at the request of the Director of Roads:

1. Angus Council (U310 Mill of Inverarity Bridge) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 for six weeks from 13 September 2000 for the purpose of bridge repairs.
2. Angus Council (John Street, Montrose) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 for two weeks from 11 September 2000 for the purpose of laying a new water main.
3. Angus Council (King's Drive, Arbroath) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 for eight hours on 2 September 2000 on the occasion of the Arbroath Highland Games.
4. Angus Council (India Lane, Montrose) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 for two weeks from 2 October 2000 for the purpose of the installation of a new water main.
5. Angus Council (Dundee Street and High Street, Carnoustie) Temporary Traffic Arrangement Orders 2000 for two weeks from 30 September 2000 for the purpose of carriageway resurfacing works.
