TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDERS

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION

ABSTRACT

This Report relates to the making of Temporary Traffic Orders as detailed below.

The Committee is requested to note that the undernoted Temporary Traffic Orders have been made at the request of the Director of Roads.

1. Angus Council (The Square, Letham) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 for 24 hours on 1 July 2000 on the occasion of a Victoria Style Street Market.
2. Angus Council (High Street/Castle Place, Montrose) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 for three hours on 4 August 2000 on the occasion of the unveiling of a new statue.
3. Angus Council (The Shore and South Street, Arbroath) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 on 12 and 13 August 2000 on the occasion of the Arbroath Seafest.
4. Angus Council (B9127 Kinnettles) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 for three weeks from 14 August 2000 for the purpose of carriageway reconstruction.
