ABSTRACT

To advise Committee of the success of Monifieth War Memorial in the Best Kept War Memorial Competition.

1 RECOMMENDATION(S)

Members are asked to note that Monifieth War Memorial was successful in achieving first place in the Best kept War Memorial competition organised by the Angus and Perthshire Area Council of the Royal British Legion, Scotland.

2 BACKGROUND

The Angus and Perthshire Area Council of the Royal British Legion Society arrange a competition on an annual basis to assess the maintenance, floral display, cleanliness and access to the war memorials in their area. The Director was delighted to receive confirmation from the Royal British Legion Society that Monifieth War Memorial achieved first place recording 48.5 points out of a possible 50 in the Best Kept War Memorial competition – Memorials with Gardens category.

This is a clear indication of the high standards of floral display design and quality of maintenance achieved by working in close partnership with Contract Services and the local branch of the Royal British Legion.
