CENTRAL GRANTS TO NATIONAL ORGANISATIONS AND OTHER OUTSIDE BODIES

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION

ABSTRACT

The purpose of this report is to seek Committee approval for the award of certain grants to national organisations.

1 RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Education Committee:

- a) approves four grants as listed in the Appendix to this report.

2 INTRODUCTION

Reference is made to the decision of the Policy and Resources Committee at its meeting on 7 May 1996 when decisions were taken on arrangements for operating grant aid across all departments of the Council (Article 3 refers). In accordance with these decisions, the grants referred to in this report relate to the Education Department.

3 RECOMMENDATIONS

COSLA previously provided a list of those organisations recommended for financial assistance by Councils, together with a recommended rate per 1,000 population. This system of recommendations ceased with effect from April 2000.

4 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The total of grants outlined in the Appendix is £5,399.00, sufficient provision for which has been included in the Education Department's Revenue Budget for Central Grants in 2002/2003.
