GOLF IN ANGUS

SUMMARY

This report sets out recommendations from the Golf Courses Member/Officer Group with regard to the management and development of Angus Council-owned golf courses.

Members will recall that in October 1999, the Policy and Resources Committee considered Report No 1084/99 by the Chief Executive ("Future Management and Development of Angus Council-owned Golf Courses" – Appendix 1).

Since then there has been considerable discussion, particularly with Carnoustie Golf Links Management Committee, which has resulted in the Chief Executive seeking a clear indication from Members as to what they wish to see achieved with regard to the management and development of Angus Council-owned golf courses.

The Golf Courses Member/Officer Group discussed the matter in detail at their meeting on 18 April 2002 and the attached paper is presented as their recommendations to the Policy and Resources Committee.
