TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDERS

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION

ABSTRACT

This Report relates to the making of Temporary Traffic Orders as detailed below.

The Committee is requested to note that the undernoted Temporary Traffic Orders have been made at the request of the Director of Roads:-

1. Angus Council (Old Ladyloan School, Arbroath) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2002 between 7 am and 6 pm commencing on Wednesday 26 June 2002 and every following Wednesday for a total of 20 weeks. The restriction shall also apply on Monday 22 July 2002 and Monday 30 September 2002 until works are completed at Arbroath Football Club.
2. Angus Council (Montrose Town Centre) (Temporary Traffic Arrangements) Order 2002 between 7 pm and 2 pm on Saturday 6 July 2002 on the occasion of the ceremony bestowing the freedom of Angus to the HMS Montrose.
3. Angus Council (Seafest, Arbroath) (Temporary Traffic Arrangements) Order 2002 on Saturday 10 August 2002 and Sunday 11 August 2002 between 8 am and 5 pm in conjunction with the Seafest.
4. Angus Council (Southesk Street, Brechin) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2002 from Monday 5 August 2002 for two weeks in order to carry out sewer replacement works.
5. Angus Council (Temporary 40mph speed restriction for the A90(T) Forfar By-pass, Junction Improvements) Order 2002 from Monday 5 August 2002 for thirty weeks for the purpose of roadworks.
6. Angus Council (Malcolm Crescent, Monifieth) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2002 from Monday 5 August 2002 for six weeks for the purpose of road reconstruction.
7. Angus Council (Mattocks Road, Wellbank) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2002 from Monday 5 August 2002 for six weeks for the purpose of carriageway repairs.
8. Angus Council (Kilry School Bridge, Kirriemuir) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2002 from Thursday 8 August 2002 for three weeks for the purpose of bridge repairs.
