(ADJACENT TO MONIKIE SCHOOL) ORDER 2002

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION

**ABSTRACT**

This Report relates to the preparation of an Order introducing a part-time 30 mph speed limit adjacent to Monikie Primary School.

**1. RECOMMENDATION**

The Committee are requested to recommend to the Council the making of this Order.

**2. INTRODUCTION**

Reference is made to Article 9 of the minute of meeting of the Roads Committee held on 22 November 2001 authorising the preparation of an Order to introduce a part-time 30 mph speed limit adjacent to Monikie Primary School.

Angus Council is participating in a pilot scheme with four other local authorities in Scotland and the scheme has already been implemented at six other locations outside schools in the Angus area. The Order will be effective until the pilot scheme ends on 30 September 2003.

The proposed Order was duly advertised and no objections were received.
