ADDITIONS TO THE LIST OF PUBLIC ROADS

REPORT BY THE ACTING DIRECTOR OF ROADS

ABSTRACT

This report informs the Committee of additions of new roads to the List of Public Roads.

1 RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Committee agrees to note the additions to the List of Public Roads.

2 INTRODUCTION

Report No. 975/96 to the Roads Committee of 28 November 1996 delegated authority to the Director of Roads to add new roads to the List of Public Roads and Report to Committee retrospectively.

Report No. 283/00 to the Roads Committee of 9 March 2000 recommended the use of Common Good money in the upgrading of Carseview Road, Forfar.

3 DETAILS

In terms of Section 1(4) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, that length of Carseview Road, Forfar listed in Appendix 1 was added to the List of Public Roads 28 days after the requisite notice was given to the frontagers of the road and such intention was advertised in the local press. (No representations were made within the statutory 28 day period following the issue/publication of these notices).

In terms of Section 16(2) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, the remaining roads listed in Appendix 1 have been added to the List of Public Roads since the last report to Committee on 23 August 2001.

4 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The revenue implications arising in respect of the routine maintenance of the additional roads and street lighting are shown in Appendix 1. These costs, totalling £4,469 for the carriageways and footways and £1,664 for street lighting, will require to be contained in future years' Roads Revenue Budgets.

5 HUMAN RIGHTS IMPLICATIONS

There are no human rights implications arising from this report.

6 CONSULTATION

The Chief Executive, the Director of Law and Administration and the Director of Finance have been consulted in the preparation of this Report.

7 CONCLUSION

The sections of new carriageway and footway listed in Appendix 1 were completed to the Council's specification subsequent to the Construction Consents being granted. Consequently, the Council as Roads Authority is obliged to add these roads to its List of Public Roads.

The section of Carseview Road which was previously unadopted has been added to the List of Public Roads following the completion of the statutory procedures required under Section 1(4) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
