NEW STREET NAMES

REPORT BY THE ACTING DIRECTOR OF ROADS

ABSTRACT

This report informs the Committee of new street names that have been authorised.

1 RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Committee agree to note the new street names listed in Appendix 1.

2 INTRODUCTION

Angus Council's Scheme of Delegation delegates authority to the Director of Roads in consultation with the Roads Convener and the local elected member to name streets or roads, subject to the proposed name not being contentious.

3 DETAILS

The names listed in Appendix 1 have been decided since April 2001.

4 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

Staff costs in administering the determination of new street names are allowed for in the Miscellaneous Other Services Budget.

There are no initial costs to Angus Council for the provision of street name plates as the developer is required to provide these as a condition of the Construction Consent.

The year-on-year costs of maintaining new street name plates will have to be contained in the Miscellaneous Other Services Budget for future years.

There are no human rights implications arising from this Report.
