ANGUS COUNCIL (OFF-STREET CAR PARKS)
(VARIATION) ORDER 2001

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION

ABSTRACT

This Report relates to the preparation of an Order varying the Off-Street Car Parks Regulations. The effect of the Order is to include two new public car parks in Stanley Street, Arbroath for long-stay periods and in Glengate, Kirriemuir for short-stay periods only.

1. RECOMMENDATION

The Committee are requested to recommend to the Council the making of the Order.

2. INTRODUCTION

Reference is made to Article 13 of the minute of meeting of the Roads Committee held on 24 August 2000 and to Article 12 of the minute of meeting of the Roads Committee held on 23 November 2000 authorising the preparation of an Order to amend the existing Off-Street Car Parks Regulations to include two new car parks for control purposes. These car parks are in Stanley Street, Arbroath for long-stay periods and in Glengate, Kirriemuir for short-stay periods only.

3. CONSULATION AND PUBLICATION

The proposed Order was duly advertised and two letters of objection were received. Following letters of explanation both letters of objection have been withdrawn.
