CORRECTION TO THE PUBLIC ROADS DATABASE
WESTHAVEN PARK, CARNOUSTIE

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF ROADS

ABSTRACT

This report recommends that the Committee agree to a correction to the Public Roads Database.

1 RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommend that the Committee agree to a correction to the Public Roads Database in relation to the registered length of footpath at Westhaven Park, Carnoustie.

2 INTRODUCTION

Following an enquiry by the Local Member regarding the status of footpaths in the Carnoustie East Ward, investigations led to the discovery of an error in the Council's Public Roads Database.

3 DETAILS

Report No. 539/89 was approved by the Roads and Transport Committee of Tayside Regional Council on 6 April 1989. This report detailed the lengths of roads at Westhaven Park which were to be added to the list of public roads at that time. The total length of footpath scheduled for adoption was 203 metres (see paragraphs (h), (i) and (j) in Appendix 1). However the Summary List of Public Roads inherited by Angus Council from Tayside Regional Council, which takes the form of a computer database, shows the length of footpath at Westhaven Park as 80 metres. In these circumstances the original adoption schedule must be assumed to be correct. There is no explanation as to how the transcription error on the computer database occurred.

In summary the length of footpath currently shown on the Public Roads Database for Westhaven Park (80m) does not correspond to the length of 203m previously approved for adoption and added to the List of Public Roads scheduled in Tayside Regional Council Report No. 539/89. It is therefore proposed that the Public Roads Database be amended to reflect the length of footpath which was adopted in 1989.

4 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no financial implications as a result of this report.

5 HUMAN RIGHTS IMPLICATIONS

There are no human rights implications arising from the proposals in this report.

6 CONSULTATION

The Chief Executive, the Director of Law and Administration and the Director of Finance have been consulted in the preparation of this Report.

7 CONCLUSION

A correction is required to the entry in the Public Roads Database for Westhaven Park, Carnoustie to correspond to the length of footpath which was approved for adoption in 1989.

Westhaven Park

- (a) Carriageway (width 5.5 m) and footways (width 1.8 m) extending from its junction with Westhaven Road in a southwesterly direction for a distance of 109 metres or thereby.
- (b) Carriageway (width 5.5 m) and footways (width 1.8 m) extending from its junction with (a) at a point 29 metres or thereby south west of Westhaven Road in a northwesterly then southwesterly direction for a distance of 94 metres or thereby and terminating in an offset turning area.
- (c) Carriageway (width 5.5 m) and footways (width 1.8 m) extending from the centre line of the junction at the termination of (a) in a northwesterly then southwesterly direction for a distance of 116 metres or thereby and terminating in an offset turning area.
- (d) Carriageway (width 5.5 m) and footways (width 1.8 m) extending from the centre line of the junction at the termination of (a) in a southeasterly then southwesterly direction for a distance of 120 metres or thereby.
- (e) Carriageway (width 5.5m) extending from the centre line of the junction at the termination of (d) in a north westerly direction for a distance of 57 metres or thereby terminating in a turning area.
- (f) Footway (width 1.8m) extending from the north west heel line at the termination of the footway of (d) in a north westerly then north easterly then north westerly then south westerly then north westerly then south westerly direction for a distance of 72 metres or thereby.
- (g) Footway (width 1.8m) extending from the south east tangent point at the junction of Westhaven Park and Westhaven Road in a north westerly direction for a distance of 36 metres or thereby.
- (h) Footpath (width 2.5m) extending from Lownie Road in a north easterly direction for a distance of 24 metres or thereby.
- (i) Footpath (width 2.5m) extending from Craig Place in a north easterly direction for a distance of 24 metres or thereby.
- (j) Footpath (width varies 2.5m to 3.0m) extending from the site boundary at Nos. 13 and 15 Linefield Road in a south easterly direction for a distance of 155 metres or thereby.
