VARIATION OF WAITING RESTRICTIONS AT MONIFIETH

REPORT BY DIRECTOR OF ROADS

ABSTRACT

This report deals with proposed amendments to current waiting restrictions to take account of changing circumstances in Monifieth.

1 RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee agree to the promotion of the necessary Traffic Regulation Variation Order to effect changes to current waiting restrictions in Monifieth

2 DETAILS

Complaints have been received regarding kerbside parking in Ashludie Terrace and Panmure Street close to the recently constructed mini-roundabout. This is causing some congestion and difficulty in negotiating the junction particularly for larger vehicles.

It is proposed therefore to introduce 'no waiting at any time' restrictions on Ashludie Terrace and Panmure Street at the approaches to the mini-roundabout.

Also, residents parking close to the junction of Albert Street and Rattray Street is causing difficulties for drivers emerging into the junction seeing oncoming traffic and vice versa.

It is proposed therefore to introduce 'no waiting at any time' restrictions at the junction to improve visibility

The above proposals are indicated on the attached plan.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The estimated cost of implementing the proposals is £1250 which will be met from the 2003/2004 Revenue Budget. Additional maintenance costs will amount to £150 per annum and these will require to be contained in future years Revenue Budgets.

4 **HUMAN RIGHTS IMPLICATIONS**

There are no human rights implications arising from the proposals in this report.

5 **CONSULTATION**

The Chief Executive, the Director of Law and Administration the Director of Finance and the Chief Constable have been consulted in the preparation of this report.

6 **CONCLUSION**

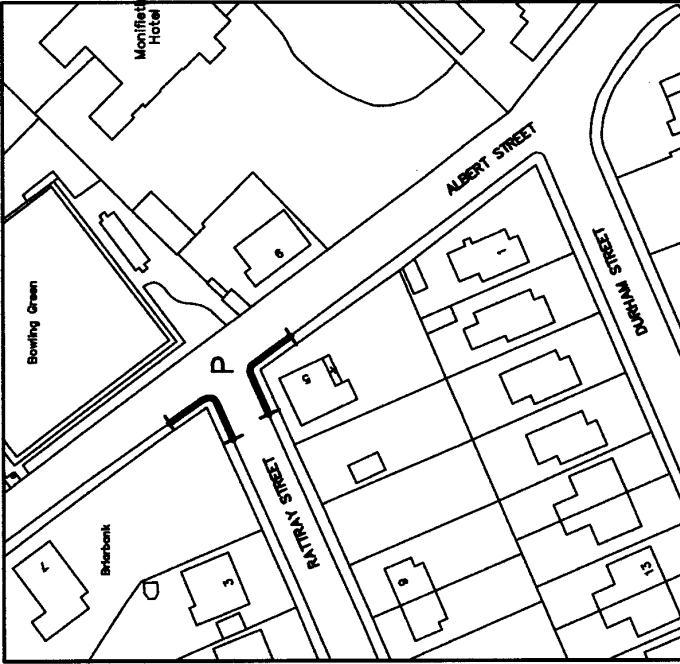

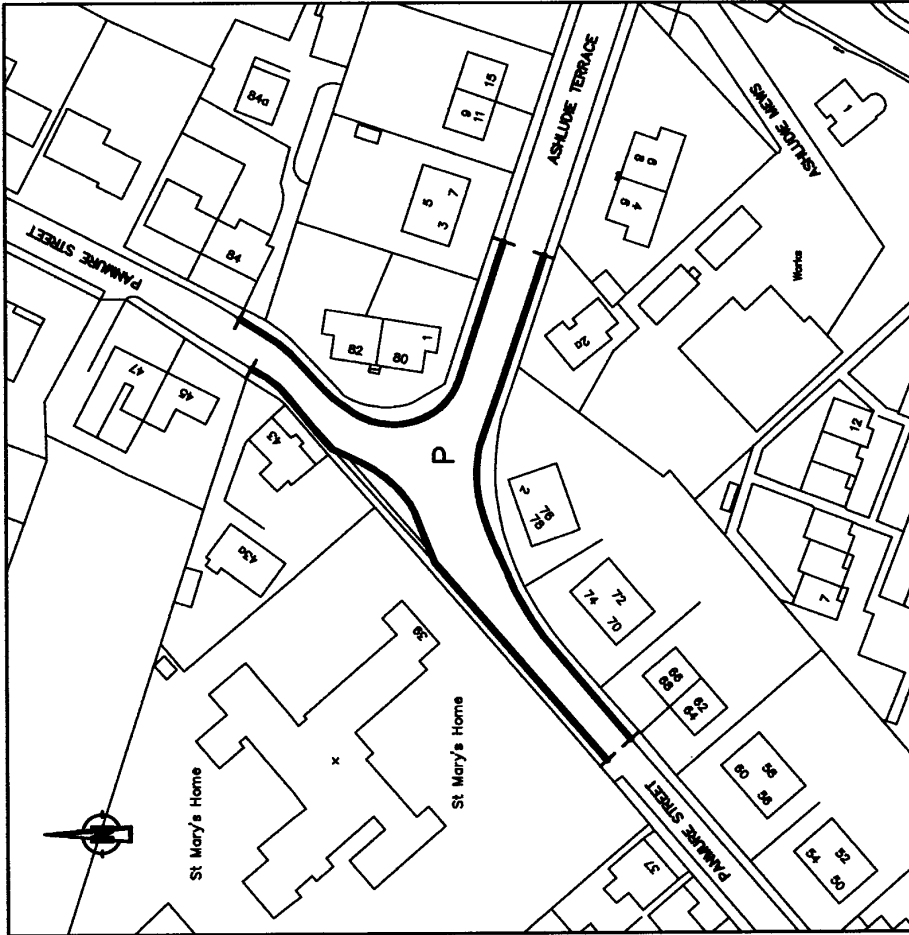
