**ANGUS COUNCIL (A929 DUNDEE - FORFAR ROAD)
(STOPPING - UP OF DISUSED LENGTHS) ORDER 2001**

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION

ABSTRACT

This Report relates to the preparation of an Order stopping up three lengths of road at Gateside which are no longer used as public roads.

2. INTRODUCTION

Reference is made to Article 352 of the Minute of Meeting of the Tayside Regional Council's Roads and Transport Committee held on 22 May 1990 authorising the preparation of an Order stopping-up three lengths of road at Gateside which were no longer necessary as public roads following the construction of a new dual carriageway.
