MARKET CONSULTATION**REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF ROADS****ABSTRACT**

This report advises the Committee of the market consultation exercise which has recently been undertaken under the CCT Regulations.

1 RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee is asked to note -

- (i) the content of Report No. 956/96 reported to the Local Services Contracts Sub-Committee on 19 December 1996,
- (ii) that the market consultation of Roads Department engineering services as required by the CCT Regulations has been carried out within the framework of a corporate strategy as described in the above report.

2 INTRODUCTION

From guidance contained within Scottish Office Circular No. 6/96 it is necessary for Authorities to consult with the market on certain matters relating to the packaging of work offered out to competition under the Local Government Act 1988. In order to satisfy the necessary timetable for the preparation for "white collar" CCT it has been necessary to undertake that consultation exercise now.

3 **DETAILS**

The market consultation exercise has been conducted for Angus Council on a corporate basis embracing all the Defined Activities covered by the 1988 Act, as described in Report No. 956/96 to the Local Services Contracts Sub-Committee on 19 December 1996.

4 **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

The financial implications in connection with the placing of the advertisements will not be significant and will be met within existing budget provision.

5 **CONSULTATION**

The Chief Executive, the Director of Law and Administration and the Director of Finance have been consulted in the preparation of this Report.
