TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDERS

The Committee is recommended to note that the undernoted Temporary Traffic Orders have been made at the request of the Director of Roads:-

- (1) Angus Council (Hill Street and Commerce Street, Arbroath) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 1997 - for ten weeks from 24 February 1997 for the purpose of water mains renewals.
- (2) Angus Council (Melville Gardens, Montrose) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 1997 - for twelve hours on 17 February 1997 on the occasion of the sitting of the Scottish Grand Committee.
- (3) Angus Council (Church Street, Brechin) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 1997 - for three weeks from 3 March 1997 for the purpose of carriageway maintenance works.
