REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDERS

The Committee is recommended to note that the undernoted Temporary Traffic Orders have been made at the request of the Director of Roads:-

- (1) Angus Council (Carnoustie Riding of the Boundary) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1997 - for ten hours on 20 April 1997.
- (2) Angus Council (Dunnichen - Boal Road, by Letham) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 1997 - for 3 weeks from 8 May 1997 for the purpose of ditch clearance, road drainage works and carriageway patching.
- (3) Angus Council (East Haven, Carnoustie) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 1997 - for 6 weeks from 19 May 1997 for the purpose of carriageway resurfacing and road drainage works.
- (4) Angus Council (Forfar - Inverquharary Road, by Forfar) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 1997 - for 6 weeks from 26 May 1997 for the purpose of road reconstruction works.
- (5) Angus Council (Justinhaugh Bridge, by Forfar) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 1997 - for ten weeks from 2 June 1997 for the purpose of bridge repairs.
