RELATING TO REPORT

16. REVIEW OF CHARGES FOR LOCAL AUTHORITY RESIDENTIAL HOMES

With reference to Article 13 of the minute of meeting of the Social Work Committee of 16 April 1996, there was submitted Report No 235/97 by the Director of Social Work proposing standard charges for residential accommodation with effect from 7 April 1997.

The Committee noted the terms of the Report and agreed:-

- (i) to approve a standard charge of £370 per week for homes for older people;
- (ii) to approve a standard charge of £585 per week for specialised dementia units;
- (iii) to approve a standard charge of £370 per week for homes for people with learning disabilities; and
- (iv) to continue to provide respite care for periods of up to 8 weeks in total, during the course of the financial year, at a fixed rate of £48.35 per week which would apply to homes for older people and homes for people with learning disabilities.
