

ANGUS COUNCIL**ROADS COMMITTEE****15 OCTOBER 1998****STOPPING UP OF A SECTION OF ROAD AT DUBTON FARM, BRECHIN****REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF ROADS****ABSTRACT**

This report deals with the proposed stopping-up of a section of road at Dubton Farm Brechin

1 RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Committee agree to the promotion of a Stopping up Order to extinguish public right of passage over a section of road at Dubton Farm, Brechin.

2 DETAILS

In the early 1970's the then A94 Forfar - Aberdeen road was upgraded and realigned in the vicinity of Dubton Farm near Brechin. The road was subsequently dualled and reclassified to the A90(T) Edinburgh - Aberdeen Trunk Road.

As a result of the original works in the early 1970's a section of road which only served as an access to Dubton Farm was intended to be stopped-up at that time but records show that the necessary formal procedures were never followed through.

A request has now been made by the adjacent landowners to formally stop-up the section of road in question thereby extinguishing public right of passage and allowing the road to revert to private access.

3 PROPOSALS

It is proposed to stop up that length of public road extending for a distance of 430 metres or thereby from its junction with North Latch Road Brechin, generally westwards to its junction with the A90(T) Edinburgh - Aberdeen Trunk Road.

The section of road to be stopped up is shown on the attached plan.

4 **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

There are no financial implications resulting from this stopping-up as the section of road in question has not been maintained since the A94 was re-aligned and there will therefore be no savings to the Council.

5 **CONSULTATION**

The Chief Executive, Director of Law and Administration, the Director of Finance and the Chief Constable have been consulted in the preparation of this Report.

6 **CONCLUSION**

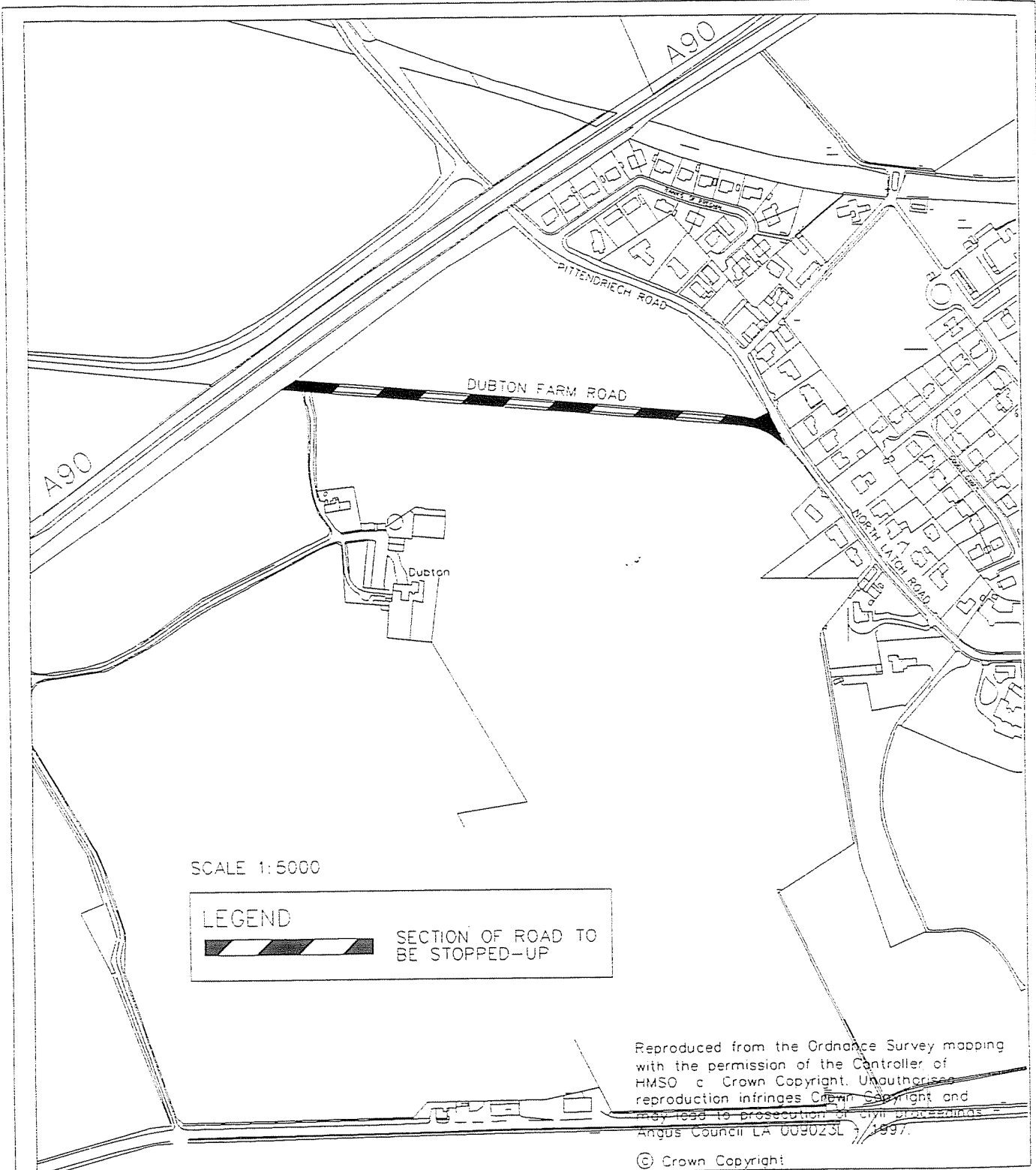
Dubton Farm Road is no longer required as a public road and in order to formally stop-up the road an Order is required.

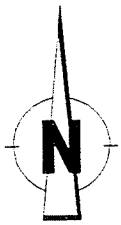
