

ANGUS COUNCIL**ROADS COMMITTEE****29 JANUARY 1998****ST ANDREWS STREET, BRECHIN - PROHIBITION OF ENTRY****REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF ROADS****ABSTRACT**

This report deals with proposal to prohibit vehicles from entering St Andrews Street northwards from its junction with Maisondieu Lane.

1 RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Committee agree to the promotion of a Traffic Regulation Order to prohibit vehicles entering St Andrews Street northwards from its junction with Maisondieu Lane.

2 DETAILS

St Andrews Street is a very narrow road with no footways. The road serves mainly residential properties but there is also a pedestrian access to Maisondieu Primary School approximately midway along its length.

Concerns have been raised by residents of St Andrews Street and parents who pick up/drop off children at the school pedestrian access about congestion in the narrowest part of the street where two-way traffic is not possible.

A one-way arrangement is not considered suitable and therefore it is proposed to prohibit entry by all vehicles to St Andrews Street from the south, to the north of its junction with Maisondieu Lane .

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The estimated cost of implementing the proposals is £600 which will be met from the 1998/99 Revenue Budget. Additional maintenance costs will amount to £20 per annum and this will require to be provided for in future years' Revenue Budgets.

4. CONSULTATION

The Chief Executive, the Director of Law and Administration, the Director of Finance and the Chief Constable have been consulted in the preparation of this report.

5 CONCLUSION

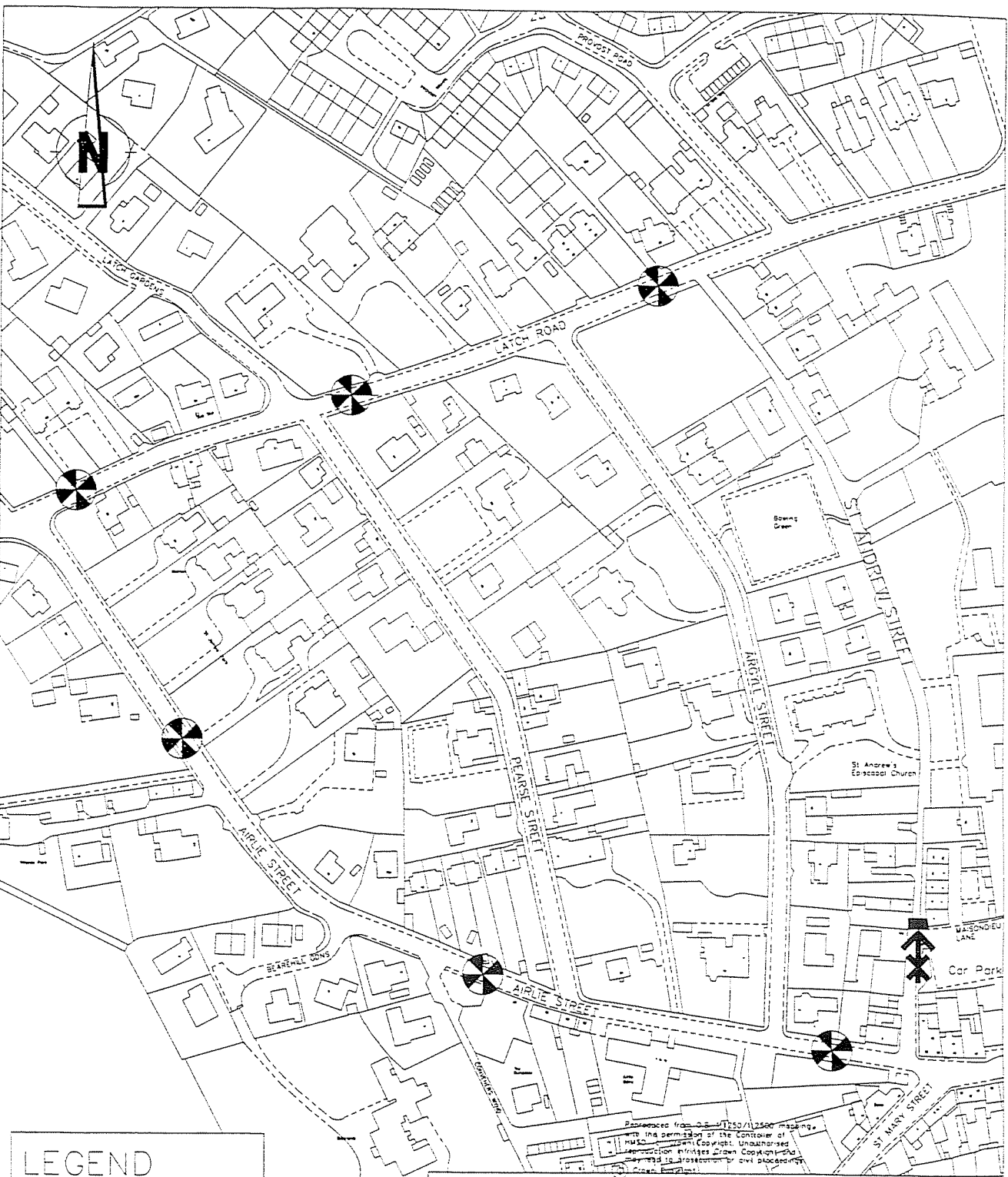
In the interest of pedestrian and traffic safety and free traffic flow prohibition of entry in St Andrews Street is considered appropriate. The promotion of a Traffic Regulation Order to implement this proposal is therefore necessary.


