TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDERS

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION

The Committee is requested to note that the undernoted Temporary Traffic Orders have been made at the request of the Director of Roads:-

- 1 Angus Council (Arbirlot Bridge, By Arbroath) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 1998 - for three weeks from 9 November 1998 for the purpose of bridge repairs.
- 2 Angus Council (High Street, Arbroath) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 1998 - for six weeks from 26 October 1998 for the purpose of road improvements.
- 3 Angus Council (Ruthven Bridge, By Alyth) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 1998 - for eight weeks from 2 November 1998 for the purpose of bridge repairs.
- 4 Angus Council (A929 Glamis Road, Forfar) (Temporary One-Way Traffic) Order 1998 - for four weeks from 9 November 1998 for the purpose of footway and carriageway resurfacing, kerbing and drainage works.
- 5 Angus Council (Kilry Road, By Alyth) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 1998 for four weeks from 16 November 1998 for the purpose of carriageway resurfacing works.
