(STOPPING-UP) ORDER 1998****REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION****ABSTRACT**

This Report relates to the preparation of an Order stopping-up three roads in Montrose which are currently wholly surrounded by an industrial development in single ownership and are considered unnecessary for public access..

1. RECOMMENDATION

The Committee are requested to recommend to the Council the making and confirming of this Order.

2. INTRODUCTION

Reference is made to Article 14 of the minute of meeting of the Roads Committee held on 17 October 1996 authorising the preparation of an Order stopping-up three roads in the Glaxo Wellcome industrial area which have become unnecessary for public access.

3. CONSULTATION AND PUBLICATION

The proposed Order was duly advertised in terms of the appropriate Regulations and one objection was received from the Montrose Port Authority. This objection was subsequently withdrawn and the said Regulations provide that in such circumstances the Council may proceed to make and confirm the Order.
