**STANDING LISTS OF CONTRACTORS FOR CONSTRUCTION, CIVIL
ENGINEERING AND ROAD MAINTENANCE CONTRACTS UNDER £200,000**

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF ROADS

ABSTRACT

This report reviews the Standing Lists of Contractors which were last reviewed by the Roads Committee on 16 October 1997.

1 RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Committee agree -

- (i) to add the contractors listed in Appendix 1 to the relevant categories of the Standing Lists of Contractors for Construction, Civil Engineering and Road Maintenance Contracts under £200,000 which were approved by the Roads Committee on 16 October 1997 (Report No 1074/97);
- (ii) that there be no further additions to these lists until the lists are next reviewed in accordance with the Council's Financial Regulations;
- (iii) that the financial limit for T Robertson & Sons be increased from £50,000 to £200,000;
- (iv) that Conjem Ltd be deleted from the Standing Lists;

- (v) that the application received from Line Markings Ltd for inclusion on the Standing List for Road Markings and Studs (Category 31) be rejected;
- (vi) that the lists shown in Appendix 2 be adopted as the Committee's Standing Lists of Contractors for Construction, Civil Engineering and Road Maintenance Contracts under £200,000.

2 INTRODUCTION

- 2.1 The Council's Financial Regulations allow each Committee to maintain standing lists of persons to be invited to tender for contracts for specified categories of work within limits stated in the Regulations. The Roads Committee of 6 March 1997 approved Standing Lists of Contractors for various categories of work which comprised those contractors whose applications had been appraised up to 28 February 1997.
- 2.2 At that time it had not been possible to complete the appraisal process in respect of some contractors whose applications had been received after the closing date or from whom further information/clarification was being sought.
- 2.3 The Committee was advised that a further report would be brought forward in due course to deal with these cases.
- 2.4 Further reports (Reports Nos 454/97, 657/97 and 1074/97) were approved by the Roads Committees of 24 April 1997, 5 June 1997 and 16 October 1997 respectively, adding to the Standing Lists those contractors for whom the appraisal process had been completed prior to the committee date.
- 2.5 This report puts forward for consideration those contractors who have applied for inclusion on the Standing Lists subsequent to the last review in October 1997 (Report No. 1074/97) and for whom the appraisal process has been completed.

- 2.6 There are also amendments required to the current Standing Lists which are detailed below.
- 2.7 With these amendments the Standing Lists can now be updated and maintained for six months pending the next review and update in accordance with the Financial Regulations.

3 DETAILS

- 3.1 The different categories of work for which Standing Lists of Contractors are maintained are shown in Appendix 3.
- 3.2 The Contractors listed in Appendix 1 have now submitted the information required in support of their applications. A full appraisal of the ability and resources of these contractors has been carried out and their technical references have been called in and appraised. The Director of Personnel has examined the Safety Policy Statements of these applicants and the Director of Finance has examined their Statements of Accounts where appropriate and has suggested the proposed placing of the firms in the £50,000 banding limit required under Financial Regulations. There is therefore now no impediment to adding these Contractors to the relevant categories of the approved Standing Lists.
- 3.3 Following an enquiry from T Robertson & Sons regarding the financial limit of £50,000 imposed after the initial financial vetting procedure, more recent supporting information was submitted which has allowed the Director of Finance to recommend that the financial limit for this firm be increased to £200,000 (categories 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 07, 09, 15, 16, 17, 23, 34, 41, 43).
- 3.4 It will also be necessary to delete Conjem Ltd from the Standing Lists (categories 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 07, 09, 10, 11, 16, 17, 18, 22, 28, 40, 41) since this firm went into voluntary liquidation in January 1998.

- 3.5 An application for inclusion on the Standing List for Category 31 (Roadmarkings and Studs) was received from Line Markings Ltd. The Committee is advised however not to add this contractor to the Standing List due to a previous history of non-compliance with contracts carried out by this firm for Tayside Regional Council. In particular, work was left uncompleted and the contractor failed to return to site to complete outstanding work within a reasonable period of time, and also failed to adopt safe working practices while carrying out work in a live traffic environment.
- 3.6 The use of the Standing Lists and selection of contractors invited to tender for individual contracts will continue to operate as described in Report No 302/97 (Roads Committee of 6 March 1997) with the deletion of Conjem Ltd from the lists previously approved and with the addition of:-
- (1) the contractors approved for addition to the Standing Lists by the Roads Committee of 24 April 1997 (Report No 454/97)
 - (2) the contractors approved for addition to the Standing Lists by the Roads Committee of 5 June 1997 (Report No 657/97)
 - (3) the contractors approved for addition to the Standing Lists by the Roads Committee of 16 October 1997 (Report No. 1074/97), and
 - (4) the contractors listed in Appendix 1 to this report.
- 3.7 With these amendments the Standing Lists can now be updated and used in accordance with the Council's Financial Regulations.
- 3.8 Appendix 2 shows the categories of work and Financial limit for each contractor on the proposed Standing Lists in summary form. A full list of contractors within each work category of the Standing Lists has been placed in members lounge for reference.

- 3.9 Financial Regulations allow the Committee to maintain its Standing Lists for a period of 3 years and require that the Lists be reviewed and updated at least every six months

4 **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

- 4.1 There are no financial implications associated with these proposals to add to, amend and maintain the Standing Lists of Contractors. The costs of any works carried out by contractors drawn from the Standing Lists will be contained within agreed budgets for the Roads Department. Separate reports regarding acceptance of tenders will be submitted in accordance with Financial Regulations in due course.

5 **CONSULTATION**

The Chief Executive, the Director of Law and Administration, the Director of Finance and the Director of Personnel have been consulted in the preparation of this Report.
