LOAN, FORFAR) ORDER 1998****REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION****ABSTRACT**

Planning permission granted in respect of the factory extension at Orchardbank Industrial Estate, Glamis Road, Forfar by Don & Low Ltd required for its implementation the stopping up of a length of road and relative footpaths at Orchard Loan, Forfar. The Council, in terms of Sections 207 and 208 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 ("the Act") made a Stopping Up of Roads and Relative Footpaths Order at Orchard Loan, Forfar authorising the required stopping up.

1. RECOMMENDATION

The Committee are asked to confirm the Stopping Up Order authorising the stopping up of a length of road and relative footpaths at Orchard Loan, Forfar.

2. BACKGROUND

The Council on 24 July 1998 gave public notice that they had made the aforementioned Stopping Up of Roads and Relative Footpaths Order. A period of 28 days from that date was allowed for making objections to the Order. No objections have been received.

3. PROPOSAL

It is proposed that the unopposed Order be confirmed in accordance with Schedule 16, Paragraph 7 of the Act.

4. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The Order has been promoted by the Council on behalf of Don & Low Ltd. All costs incurred in the promotion of the Order will be recovered from Don & Low Ltd.
