PUBLIC HOLIDAYS 2004

ABSTRACT

This report informs Members on the arrangements made for Public Holidays in 2004 within Contract Services.

1. RECOMMENDATION

2. BACKGROUND

Members will be aware that a local agreement exists with the Trade Unions by which all twelve public holidays have to be fixed for manual workers within Ground Maintenance and Leisure Management. These are the seven days set by Council and five dates determined by negotiation but normally linked to the traditional local holidays.

Negotiations have taken place within the Departmental Consultative Group and the agreed dates are:

Tuesday	23	March	2004
Monday	17	May	2004
Monday	26	July	2004
Monday	4	October	2004
