ARTS AND HERITAGE GRANT AID

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LEISURE SERVICES

ABSTRACT

This report informs members of the Arts and Heritage Grant Aid application of £500 or less which has been dealt with since 16 October 2003 through the Arts and Heritage section of the Corporate Grant Aid to the Voluntary/Community Sector Scheme.
