BEST KEPT WAR MEMORIAL

ABSTRACT

To advise Committee of the success of Edzell and Monifieth War Memorials in the Best Kept War Memorial Competition for the Angus & Perthshire area.

1. RECOMMENDATION(S)

Members are asked to note that Edzell War Memorial was successful in achieving first place in the Small Communities Category and Monifieth War Memorial was first place in the "With Gardens" category.

2. BACKGROUND AND PROPOSALS

The Angus and Perthshire Area Council of the Royal British Legion Society arrange a competition on an annual basis to assess the maintenance, floral display, cleanliness and access to the war memorials in their area. The Director was delighted to receive confirmation from the Royal British Legion Society that Monifieth War Memorial achieved first place recording 38.5 points out of a possible 40 in the Best Kept War Memorial competition – Memorials with Gardens category and that Edzell achieved first place recording 38 points out of 40 in the Small Communities category.

This is a clear indication of the high standards of floral display design and quality of maintenance achieved by working in close partnership with Contract Services and the local branch of the Royal British Legion.

These two war memorials will now go forward for judging on a Scotland wide basis. Members were advised that Carnoustie as the overall National winner in 2002 automatically goes into the final judging at the National Competition on 20 - 21 August.
