FORMER REGISTRATION OFFICE, BRECHIN

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION

ABSTRACT

This Report advises that the former Registration Office in Brechin is now surplus to the requirements of the Law and Administration Department and recommends that the Director of Property Services be authorised to consider its future use.

1. RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Committee:-

- (i) notes that the former Registration Office at Panmure Street, Brechin is now surplus to the requirements of the Department of Law and Administration; and
- (ii) instructs the Director of Property Services to consider the options for the future use of this property and report back to this Committee in due course.

2. INTRODUCTION

Reference is made to Article 44 of the minute of meeting of this Committee of 4 September 2003 when it was agreed to concentrate the provision of the Council's statutory functions in relation to the registration of births, deaths and marriages in 3 dedicated full time offices in Arbroath, Forfar and Montrose with effect from 1 January 2004. As a result of the implementation of this decision the former Registration Office at Panmure Street, Brechin has been vacated and is surplus to the requirements of this Department. It is now appropriate that the Director of Property Services should give consideration to the options for the future use of this property.
