

MONTROSE TOWN HOUSE – CRYPT

Abstract

This report seeks approval to erect a mesh behind the gates of the Crypt below Montrose Town House funded from Montrose Common Good Funds.

1 RECOMMENDATION

The Resources and Central Services Committee is recommended to approve the request for funding from the Common Good Fund amounting to £1430.06 to erect a mesh behind the gates of the Crypt below Montrose Town House.

2 BACKGROUND AND PROPOSAL

At present any litter and debris picked up by the wind accumulates in the Crypt below Montrose Town House. It is therefore proposed to erect a mesh behind the gates of the Crypt to stop wind blown litter or any other debris entering. The Director of Property Services has obtained a quotation from Harry Maiden Ltd for putting up a black painted galvanised mild steel mesh behind the iron gates for the sum of £1430.06.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The cost of £1430.06 would be met from the Montrose Common Good Fund.

The Chief Executive, Director of Law & Administration, Director of Finance and Montrose Members have been consulted in the preparation of this report.
