SUBJECT: RENEWAL & REPAIRS FUNDS FOR PROPERTY, ROADS, INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, EQUIPMENT, AND PRINTING AT 31 JULY 2005

REPORT BY ACTING DIRECTOR OF FINANCE

Abstract: The purpose of this report is to report on the actual financial position of the Renewal & Repairs Funds for Property, Roads, Information Technology, Equipment, and Print as at 31 July 2005.

1 RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee generally notes the contents of this report and agrees that the balance on the Vehicle Renewal & Repairs be transferred to the Asset Replacement Reserve.

2 COMMENTARY

- 2.1 The estimated uncommitted balance available on the funds, as shown on the attached [Appendices 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6](#), is some £1,761,710 (Property-£535,546 Information Technology-£378,773, Roads-£601,964 Equipment-£28,407, and Print Unit-£217,020).
- 2.2 Members should note that the estimated uncommitted balance on the Information Technology Fund does not include commitments in respect of supporting the General Fund Information Technology Fund Capital Plan beyond 2005/06 amounting to some £211k.
- 2.3 At the end of financial year 2004/05 there remained a balance of £53,855 within the Vehicle Renewal and Repair Fund. It is therefore appropriate to transfer this balance to the Asset Replacement Reserve in financial year 2005/06.
