AGNES LOWSON FUND

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION

ABSTRACT

This purpose of this Report is to advise members of the resignation of a Trustee.

1. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommend that members agree that the Trustees to the Agnes Lowson Fund be the Provost, the Depute Provost and the Councillor of Ward 7 and one Forfar Minister.

2. BACKGROUND

Reference is made to Report No 831/04 which advised that the Trust's purposes enabled the funds to be distributed throughout Angus and recommended the appointment of the Provost and Depute Provost in addition to one Forfar Councillor to establish a more Angus wide representation. At that time, two local Forfar Ministers were also acting as Trustees of the Trust. During the summer months, notice was received from the Reverend Robert McCrum that he wished to resign as a Trustee of the Agnes Lowson Fund and this Report notifies members of that resignation.

The original Trust Fund did not detail the number of Trustees required and accordingly it is recommended that the Trustees should remain as the Provost, the Depute Provost the Councillor for Ward 7 and one other Forfar Minister, who at present is the Reverend Graham Norrie.
