**ABSTRACT**

This Report and attached appendix relates to the making of Temporary Traffic Orders as detailed below.

**1. RECOMMENDATIONS**

The Committee is requested to note that the undernoted Temporary Traffic Orders have been made at the request of the Head of Roads:

- (i) The Angus Council (Forfar v Glasgow Rangers Football Match) (Temporary Traffic Arrangement) Order 2009 between the hours of 7.00am and 6.00pm on Sunday 8 February 2009 in order to facilitate the Football Match between Forfar and Glasgow Rangers.
- (ii) The Angus Council (Muir of Pert Bridge) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2009 for 5 weeks commencing on Monday 16 February 2009 for the purposes of carrying out bridge repairs.
