**NEW STREET NAMES**

**REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF INFRASTRUCTURE SERVICES**

**ABSTRACT**

This report informs the Committee of new street names which were authorised under delegated authority in 2008/09.

**1 RECOMMENDATIONS**

- 1.1 It is recommended that the Committee notes the new street names which were authorised by the Head of Roads under delegated authority in 2008/09 as listed in Appendix 1

**2 INTRODUCTION**

- 2.1 Angus Council's Scheme of Delegation authorises the Head of Roads in consultation with the Convener of the Infrastructure Services Committee and the local elected members to name new streets or roads, subject to the proposed names not being contentious.

**3 DETAILS**

- 3.1 The new street names listed in Appendix 1 were so authorised in 2008/09.

**4 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

- 4.1 A sum of £20,000 is provided for within the Miscellaneous Other Services budget to meet the costs associated with new street name plates. The staff costs in administering the determination of new street names are met from this budget.
- 4.2 There are no initial capital costs to Angus Council for the provision of street name plates as the developer is required to provide these as a condition of the Road Construction Consent where granted under Section 21 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
- 4.3 The year on year revenue costs of maintaining new street name plates will have to be contained within the provision for Street Name Plates included within the Miscellaneous Other Services Revenue Budget in future years.

**5 HUMAN RIGHTS IMPLICATIONS**

- 5.1 There are no human rights implications arising from the proposals in this report.

## 6 EQUALITIES IMPLICATIONS
