TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDERS

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF CORPORATE SERVICES

ABSTRACT

This Report relates to the making of Temporary Traffic Orders as detailed below.

1. RECOMMENDATION

The Committee is requested to note that the undernoted Temporary Traffic Orders have been made at the request of the Head of Roads:

- (i) The Angus Council (Traill Drive, Montrose) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) Order 2009 between the hours of 10.00am and 12.00pm on Sunday 12 April 2009 for the purposes of holding a 10k Road Race; and
- (ii) The Angus Council (Car Park, High Street, Montrose) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) Order 2009 between the hours of 8.00am and 5.30pm on Saturday 30 May 2009 for the purposes of holding a Music Festival.
