TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDERS

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF CORPORATE SERVICES

**ABSTRACT**

This Report relates to the making of Temporary Traffic Orders as detailed below.

**1. RECOMMENDATION**

The Committee is requested to note that the undernoted Temporary Traffic Orders have been made at the request of the Head of Roads:

- (i) The Angus Council (Balmain Street, Montrose) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) Order 2009 for 6 weeks from 7.00am on Monday 24 August 2009 for the purposes of carrying out carriageway and footway reconstruction works.
- (ii) The Angus Council (Grange Road, Monifieth and junctions between Ferry Road and Milton Street and Ferry Road and Panmuirfield Road, Monifieth) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2009 for 2 weeks from 7.00am on Monday 14 September 2009 for the purposes of carrying out carriageway resurfacing works and in order to maintain traffic safety.
- (iii) The Angus Council (Mid Links, Montrose) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) Order 2009 between the hours of 7.00am and 7.00pm on Sunday 6 September 2009 for the purpose of holding the Over the Rainbow Fun Day Event.
- (iv) The Angus Council (Channonry Wynd, Brechin) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) Order 2009 for 4 weeks commencing Monday 14 September 2009, between 9.00am and 5.00pm daily for the purpose of wall repairs.
- (v) The Angus Council (Eastmill Road, Brechin) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) Order 2009 for 4 weeks commencing Monday 28 September 2009 for the purposes of carrying out a gas main replacement.
- (vi) The Angus Council (Hillend, Lownie, Kingsmuir, By Forfar) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2009 for 12 weeks commencing Monday 21 September 2009 for the purposes of carrying out junction improvement works.
- (vii) The Angus Council (The Dunhill Links Championship 2009, Carnoustie) (Temporary Traffic Arrangements) Order 2009 from 7.00am on Monday 28 September 2009 until 8.00pm on Saturday 3 October 2009 in order to facilitate the Alfred Dunhill Links Championship 2009 at Carnoustie golf links.
- (viii) The Angus Council (A933 Colliston – Leysmill, by Arbroath) (Temporary Traffic Arrangements) Order 2009 for 9 weeks commencing Monday 12 October 2009 for the purposes of carrying out road resurfacing works.
- (ix) The Angus Council (A937 North Craigo to Marykirk Bridge, Montrose) (Temporary Traffic Arrangement) Order 2009 for 6 weeks commencing Wednesday 14 October 2009 for the purposes of carrying out carriageway maintenance works.
- (x) The Angus Council (South Esk Street, Montrose) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) Order 2009 for 13 months commencing Friday 2 October 2009 in order to facilitate the proposed building works that are to be executed on or near South Esk Street, Montrose.
