REPORT BY THE CLERK

ABSTRACT

The purpose of this Report is to advise members of applications for a Personal Licence under the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 which have been granted by the Clerk to the Licensing Board in accordance with the Scheme of Delegation appended to the Licensing Policy.

1. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board note the licences granted under delegated authority as detailed in the attached Appendix.

2. BACKGROUND

In terms of the Scheme of Delegation to Officers detailed in Appendix 1, paragraph 3.3 of Angus Licensing Board Statement of Licensing Policy, the Clerk to the Licensing Board is authorised to grant certain applications in connection with certain licences received under the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.
