**ABSTRACT:**

This report presents the 2012/13 full year progress report on the Angus Community Plan and Single Outcome Agreement 2011/14, prior to submission to the Scottish Government by the end of September.

Following consideration of draft full year progress reports at the Thematic Partnerships' Group meeting on 27 June 2013, a summary progress report on the five partnership priorities has been compiled for submission to Scottish Government, which gives an overview of performance for the past year.

Overall, the performance of the Angus Community Planning Partnership has been relatively positive with 65% of the indicators meeting or exceeding target with 63% of the indicators having improved on the previous year's performance.
