PUBLIC HOLIDAYS 2001

**ABSTRACT**

This report informs Members on the arrangements made for Public Holidays in 2001 within Contract Services.

**1. RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that Members note the report.

**2. BACKGROUND**

Members will be aware that a local agreement exists with the Trade Unions by which all twelve public holidays have to be fixed for manual workers within Ground Maintenance, Leisure Management. These are the seven days set by Council and five dates determined by negotiation but normally linked to the traditional local holidays.

Negotiations have taken place within the Departmental Consultative Group and the agreed dates are shown in the appendix.
