SCHOOL CAPACITIES AND INTAKE LIMITS

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION

ABSTRACT

This report recommends adoption of amended school capacities and intake limits.

1 RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Education Committee:

- a notes the contents of this report;
- b approves the amended school capacities and intake limits (Appendix); and
- c notes that any future reductions in maximum class sizes may result in further alterations to the capacities and intake limits now being proposed

2 BACKGROUND

2.1 Reference is made to meetings of the Education Committee:

- a on 21 January 1997 when school capacities and intake limits for all Angus schools were approved (Article 6 of the minute of the meeting refers)
- b on 24 November 1998 when amendments were agreed to the notional school capacity and intake limit of Arbroath High School (Article 10 of the minute of the meeting refers)
- c on 7 March 2000 when I was instructed to report back to the Education Committee on the outcome of consultations with School Boards about proposals to amend the capacities and intake limits of 26 primary schools in order to take account of the Education (Lower Primary Class Sizes) (Scotland) Regulations 1999
(Article 7 of the minute of the meeting refers)

2.2 Five School Boards responded to the consultation described in (c) above. All were supportive in principle of the proposals, although two Boards specifically highlighted the need for some flexibility in the implementation of intake limits.

3 ADOPTION OF AMENDED SCHOOL CAPACITIES AND INTAKE LIMITS

3.1 It is recommended that the proposed amendments to school capacities and intake limits should now be adopted for all 26 of the primary schools affected. These amendments have been incorporated into the list of school capacities/intake limits for all Angus schools - see Appendix.

- 3.2 The need for flexibility highlighted by two of the School Board responses is worth re-emphasising. Although it is essential for the Council to adopt prudent intake limits for all its schools, there may be occasions when these limits need to be exceeded - particularly if there is sufficient space in the school as a whole and no long-term disadvantages are likely to accrue to pupils in the school if the limit is exceeded in one particular year.
- 3.3 It is also worth noting that the capacities and intake limits in the attached Appendix derive partly from the maximum class sizes currently imposed by legislation. It is possible that current maxima may be reduced (eg as a result of recommendations expected shortly from the McCrone Committee). In these circumstances, it may be necessary to review once again school capacities and intake limits.

4 CONSULTATION

- 4.1 In accordance with the Standing Orders of the Council, this report has been the subject of consultation with the Chief Executive, the Director of Finance and the Director of Law & Administration.
