COMMUNITY EDUCATION SERVICE
REVENUE GRANT TO VOLUNTARY ORGANISATIONS 2000/2001

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION

ABSTRACT

This Report makes recommendation to the Committee on an application for a Revenue Grant over £500 to a Voluntary Organisation.

1 RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Education Committee approves a revenue grant of £1,750 as detailed in Appendix 1.

2 INTRODUCTION

Reference is made to the decision of the Policy and Resources Committee at its meeting on 7 May 1996 when decisions were taken on arrangements for operating grant aid across all departments of the Council (Article 3 refers). In accordance with these decisions, the grants referred to in this Report relate to the Education Department.

3 CONDITIONS AND PRIORITIES

The conditions which have to be satisfied in order that Voluntary Organisations qualify for Revenue Grant support are detailed within the Council's Guidance Notes on Grant Aid to the Voluntary Sector, and were approved in Report No 317/96.

4 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The recommended award of £1,750 can be met from the 2000/2001 Education Department's Revenue Budget to Voluntary Organisations in Angus.

5 CONSULTATION

The Chief Executive, the Director of Law and Administration and the Director of Finance have been consulted in the preparation of this Report.

6 HUMAN RIGHTS

There are no Human Rights implications arising directly from consideration of this report.

7 CONCLUSION

It is recommended that the Committee approve a revenue grant of £1,750 detailed in Appendix 1.
