## REPORT BY DIRECTOR OF ENVIRONMENTAL AND CONSUMER PROTECTION

**ABSTRACT**

Due to staff holidays within Contract Services (Cleansing) the arrangements for the various cleansing services including refuse collection over the festive period requires to be altered.

**1. RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Committee approve the adjusted rotas for refuse and wastepaper collections and other cleansing services over the festive period as detailed in this report.

**Note to Rota**

- Each household and commercial service users affected by the changes in service will receive a hand bill showing their collection day and other changes to the normal rota.
- The bulky items special collection service will be rescheduled during this period.
- There will be no domestic waste paper collection during the week commencing 25 December 2000 and 1 January 2001. The rescheduled collection date will be advised on calendars supplied to householders.
- Commercial collections including cardboard and glass collections will be adjusted and handbills provided showing details to all our customers.

### **3. PUBLIC TOILETS**

Town Centre Superloos will be closed on 25 and 26 December and 1 and 2 January. Otherwise unattended toilets will operate on a reduced service in each town during this period.

### **4. RECYCLING CENTRES**

Recycling Centres will all be closed on 25 and 26 December and 1 and 2 January.

### **5. STREET CLEANING**

Town Centre streets will require a reduced level of cleaning on 25 and 26 December and 2 January. An early morning skeleton service will be provided on the morning of 1 January to deal with Hogmanay littering.

### **6. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

The costs will be accommodated from within the cash limited budget for Waste Management Services.

### **7. CONSULTATION**

The Chief Executive, Director of Finance, Director of Law and Administration and Contract Services Manager have been consulted on the contents of this report.
