TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDERS

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION

**ABSTRACT**

This Report relates to the making of Temporary Traffic Orders as detailed below.

The Committee is requested to note that the undernoted Temporary Traffic Orders have been made at the request of the Director of Roads:

1. Angus Council (High Street and Murray Street, Montrose) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 1999 - for 7 hours on 12 December 1999 in conjunction with a Christmas Extravaganza.
2. Angus Council (The Den, Letham) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 1999 - for six weeks from 29 November 1999 for the purpose of installing a replacement water main.
3. Angus Council (High Street, Brechin) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 1999 - for 6 hours on 18 December 1999 in conjunction with a Christmas Extravaganza.
4. Angus Council (A935 Forfar Road, Brechin) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 - for six weeks from 17 January 2000 for the purpose of installing a new sewer connection.
