TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDERS

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION

**ABSTRACT**

This Report relates to the making of Temporary Traffic Orders as detailed below.

The Committee is requested to note that the undernoted Temporary Traffic Orders have been made at the request of the Director of Roads.

1. Angus Council (Kinnaird Bridge, Lintrathen) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 - for eight weeks from 21 February 2000 for the purpose of bridge repair works.
2. Angus Council (Park Road Railway Bridge, Brechin) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 - for four weeks from 28 February 2000 for the purpose of bridge repair works.
3. Angus Council (South Union Street, Monifieth) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 - for four weeks from 6 March 2000 for the purpose of laying a new sewer.
4. Angus Council (Hamilton Green, Arbroath) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 - for twelve months from 10 April 2000 for the purpose of the construction of a new Visitors Centre at Arbroath Abbey.
5. Angus Council (B966 Gannochy Bridge, Edzell) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 - for four weeks from 1 April 2000 for the purpose of bridge repairs.
6. Angus Council (Little Brechin) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 - for eleven hours on 8 July on the occasion of a street party.
7. Angus Council (Abbey Path, Arbroath) (Temporary Traffic Arrangements) Order 2000 - for six weeks from 13 April 2000 for the purpose of the construction of the Visitors Centre at Arbroath Abbey.
8. Angus Council (Castle Street/Victoria Street, Forfar) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2000 - for six weeks from 19 April 2000 for the purpose of sewer improvements.
