

## **MAISONDIEU PRIMARY SCHOOL - REFURBISHMENT OF LIGHTING- CLASSROOMS AND CORRIDOR**

### **Abstract**

This report seeks approval to the provision of supplementary funding from the Property Renewal and Repair Fund to cover the cost of the refurbishment of classroom and corridor lighting at an estimated cost of £10,000.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

The Committees for their respective interests are recommended to:

1. note the requirement for the refurbishment of classroom and corridor lighting at Maisondieu Primary School,
2. approve the bid for supplementary funding in the sum of £10,000 from the Property Renewal and Repair Fund,

## **1 BACKGROUND**

Recent inspections of Maisondieu Primary School have identified that the standard of lighting in classrooms and corridors is currently well below modern standards and that action is needed.

It has been agreed with the Director of Education that an intermittent programme of upgrading of lighting in schools will be undertaken on an opportunistic basis i.e. when other competing priorities permit appropriate funding to be made available.

## **2 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

The cost of the refurbishment has been estimated at £10,000 and cannot be contained within the Property Maintenance Revenue budget for the Education department.

It is therefore necessary for supplementary funding to be made available from the Property Renewal and Repair fund to carry out the necessary repairs.

The repairs detailed in this report can be contained within the provisions of the Property Renewal and Repair fund for 2001/02.

### 3 HUMAN RIGHTS ACT IMPLICATIONS

There are no Human Rights Act implications specific to this report.

Any implications, as a consequence of discharging recommendations detailed in this report, will be managed in accordance with the standing procedures and processes established by the Property Services department.
