TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDERS
REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION

ABSTRACT

This Report relates to the making of Temporary Traffic Orders as detailed below.

The Committee is requested to note that the undernoted Temporary Traffic Orders have been made at the request of the Director of Roads:-

1. Angus Council (Hill Street, Arbroath) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2001 for two weeks from 20 January 2001 for the purpose of carriageway repairs.
2. Angus Council (Kirkton of Menmuir) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2001 for two weeks from 22 January 2001 for the purpose of replacing a culvert.
3. Angus Council (River Street, Brechin) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2001 for six weeks from 22 January 2001 for the purpose of laying a new sewer.
4. Angus Council (High Street, Brechin) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2001 for approximately seven hours on 11 January 2001 on the occasion of a film shoot.
5. Angus Council (Woodville, Arbroath) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Temporary Speed Restriction) Order 2001 for six weeks from 12 February 2001 for the purpose of carriageway repairs.
