

PRICING POLICY 2016/17

for ANGUSalve Facilities

The Charges are updated each year (normally for April) and indicate the level of charges for the current year.

1. All users (except those attending club and private sessions), shall be given the option of accessing the indoor sports facilities, synthetic pitches, swimming pools, town halls, countryside car parking and countryside water sports/outdoor activities by a Monthly Direct Debit (DD), as part of ANGUSalve's bACTIVE Scheme.
2. Start-up fees for the bACTIVE scheme are based on the monthly charges particularly to that membership category.
3. ANGUSalve, Angus Council and Dundee & Angus College employees, will be offered a 25% discount on standard, joint and family memberships of the ANGUSalve bACTIVE Scheme.
4. Businesses/Organisations will be offered a 10% discount off the standard, joint and family membership charges of ANGUSalve's bACTIVE Scheme if 10 or more of their employees / members join.
5. Offshore workers will be offered a discounted annual membership of the ANGUSalve bACTIVE Scheme based on 9 times the current monthly standard rate which can be paid annually or in 12 monthly installments (minimum 12 months contract).
6. A joint membership option of the ANGUSalve bACTIVE Scheme will be available for any two people staying at the same address. Proof of address required.
7. A family membership option of the ANGUSalve bACTIVE Scheme will be available for a maximum of two adults and any children aged 17 or under or still in secondary education staying at the same address.
8. bACTIVE members will be offered a 25% discount on personal training and one to one swimming lesson charges.
9. Access to the Health Suite includes a free swim when available.
10. A family swim option will be available for up to two adults and three children aged 17 years of age or under.
11. Charges for squash matches will be based on the standard adult and concessionary activity rates.
12. The Angus concessionary entitlement scheme is available to Senior Citizens (60 years and over), Registered Unemployed, Full Time Students, residents in receipt of Working Tax Credit, Disabilities Tax Credit or Income Support. Subject to proof of entitlement and a 12 month fee.
13. Junior charges to apply to juveniles aged 17 years of age or under.
14. Customers who are registered as Angus Carers will be entitled to concessionary rates.
15. Customers who are registered as Young Carers will be entitled to the same free use as bACTIVE members.
16. Customers who require assistance when using facilities may apply for the Angus Buddy Scheme. This scheme will allow service users support when attending or taking part in physical activity sessions by allowing the buddy to attend the session at no financial cost.
17. Angus Gold card and National Entitlement Card (NEC) holders will be entitled to concessionary swims.
18. Angus athletes who are in national squads at Scottish, United Kingdom or Great British levels can enroll on the NASA scheme which will entitle them to free use of leisure facilities, relevant to their training programme.
19. Clubs registered for the Angus ACE awards will be entitled to club charges.
20. Club rates only apply to block bookings.
21. Clubs will be charged the mixed rate when 50% or more of the participants attending the session are aged 17 or under.
22. A seasonal charge for the use of grass pitches and changing rooms is available.
23. The minimum charge when booking sports facilities and synthetic pitches will be based on the following occupancies:

Full synthetic pitch (Arbroath, Station Park)	22
Half synthetic pitch (Arbroath, Station Park)	14
Quarter synthetic pitch (Arbroath, Station Park)	10
Full synthetic pitch (Pitskelly, Webster's)	14
Half synthetic pitch (Pitskelly, Webster's)	10
Full synthetic pitch (Brechtin)	10
24. Town hall hourly charges, where appropriate, are based on a minimum charge of two hours, with the exception of sports bookings.
25. Customers will be given a 50% discount off hourly, daily and weekly Lesser Town Hall charges if they have also booked the main hall.
26. Normal charges relate to bookings within normal opening hours or between 9am-12 midnight at town halls. Where booking extends beyond this period an additional hourly staff charge may be applied.
27. A fee is payable to the Performing Rights Society when live or recorded music is performed within any of our venues. This fee is based on the type of performance/activity, the material played, and where appropriate, box office receipts. All required returns must be submitted within 30 days of the performance to the relevant office.
28. In connection with town hall bookings non-commercial charges will apply to the categories listed below:
 - Local voluntary organization meetings and events;
 - Rehearsals and performances by local music and dramatic groups (town halls);
 - Local flower, craft, bird or dog shows or similar;
 - Weddings, birthday parties or similar family events.
29. Commercial rate charges will apply to all bookings run for business, commercial or political purposes, unless otherwise authorised by the Chief Executive, ANGUSalve.
30. The bar charges will apply to anyone selling non alcoholic or alcoholic drinks within town hall premises.
31. A 25% non-refundable deposit will apply for bookings within Town Hall premises.
32. Sports bookings by clubs, organisations or individuals using any town hall will be charged at the appropriate area charge. Activity examples being football, badminton, boxing, bowls, martial arts, highland dancing, aerobics and keep fit.
